# ORDER OF THE ARROW

## Chapter Most Valuable Arrowmen (MVA) Award Requirements

The Chapter Most Valuable Arrowman Award recognizes an Arrowman who exemplifies the highest ideals of the Order of the Arrow through service, leadership, and cheerful spirit within the chapter and the lodge.

### 1. Membership

- Must be a **current, dues-paid member** of the lodge and active within the chapter.
- Must be in **good standing** with their unit and the Boy Scouts of America.

### 2. Chapter Participation

- Demonstrates **consistent attendance** at chapter meetings, events, and activities.
- Actively participates in **chapter service projects**, ceremonies, or program support.

### 3. Service to the Chapter

- Provides **significant service** to the chapter during the award period (usually the past year).
- Frequently volunteers for tasks, projects, or leadership responsibilities without being asked.

- Shows a willingness to help with **chapter administration**, event setup, recruitment, or communication.

#### 4. Leadership and Example

- Exhibits the **Scout Oath and Law** and the principles of **Brotherhood, Cheerfulness, and Service** in all actions.
- Serves as a **positive role model** for younger or newly inducted Arrowmen.
- If holding a leadership position, fulfills the responsibilities of that role with excellence.

#### 5. Contribution to Lodge and Community

- Contributes to **lodge-level events**, such as Ordeals, fellowships, service days, or ceremonies.
- Promotes camping, service, and cheerful leadership in their **unit, district, or community**.

#### 6. Spirit of the Order

- Demonstrates a **consistent cheerful attitude**, willingness to serve, and spirit of brotherhood.
- Is recognized by peers and chapter leadership as someone who “goes above and beyond.”
